## **Where Beats This Human Heart**

**Where Beats This Human Heart** is a forthcoming show of new work by artists Luke Montgomery, Nelly Ben Hayoun, Sandy Smith, Will Mackrell and Xavier Poultney.

A disused WWII air raid shelter in Dalston, East London, is the backdrop for the exhibition. Inside the passages and chambers of this dark and cavernous subterranea these 5 artists have created a spectacle of sensory and experiential overload - a body of site-specific work that stimulates and challenges the viewers' senses and responses, both to the artwork and to the location.

Space In Between invited the artists to react to the unique and challenging space; to its history as a place of sanctuary from the nightly air raids of wartime London, and to its present state as a derelict, defunct and pitch black concrete shell. Each artist has developed their work in response to the space and in conversation with each other, using elements of darkness and light, sound, silence and theatre.

**Where Beats This Human Heart** is a homage to the bunker, serving as a reminder of the beating hearts that sought shelter in its chambers whilst simultaneously triumphing, like Keats' Hyperion, and re-illuminating its shadows.
