Space in Between are delighted to present a solo show of new work by artist Lilah Fowler.

Fowler's practice explores ideas around the imprint of time on an object and how it influences our perception of space and our consecutive experience of it. These works are installed in response to the gallery environment and, in that way, formulate a serendipitous and spontaneous reaction to form, space and surface.

As with all Fowler's works there is a play between illusion and perspective. The subjective experiences of the works themselves – psychological and haptic – can be as important as the bodily navigation around them and the spaces left between.

In works, such as *pie*, *diamond* and *triangle*, Fowler creates a 'feeling' of space within three painted steel frames, one covered in fabric. Here the silhouettes of the frames' outlines are layered upon themselves, creating a number of varying partitions, gaps and pockets within the space where they come to rest.

Fowler is interested in how the reproduction of *motif* can essentially render the form functionless and become a simple surface. It is this simultaneous play between sensations of depth and solidity that is tantamount to the works presented. Even the title – '*band*' – implies several interpretations: A grouping of objects, a repetition of circular forms and also that of a layer.
